Ceremonies can take place in a number of local Churches or on-site indoor or outdoor in Rathsallagh's magnificent walled garden. Rathsallagh has 33 rooms in the House and Courtyards and six additional rooms in its two Lodges. There is additional accommodation available locally.

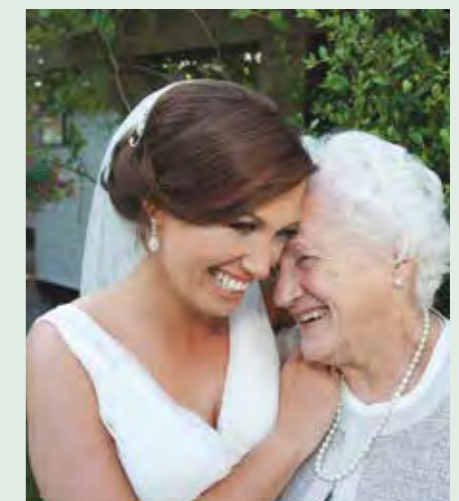

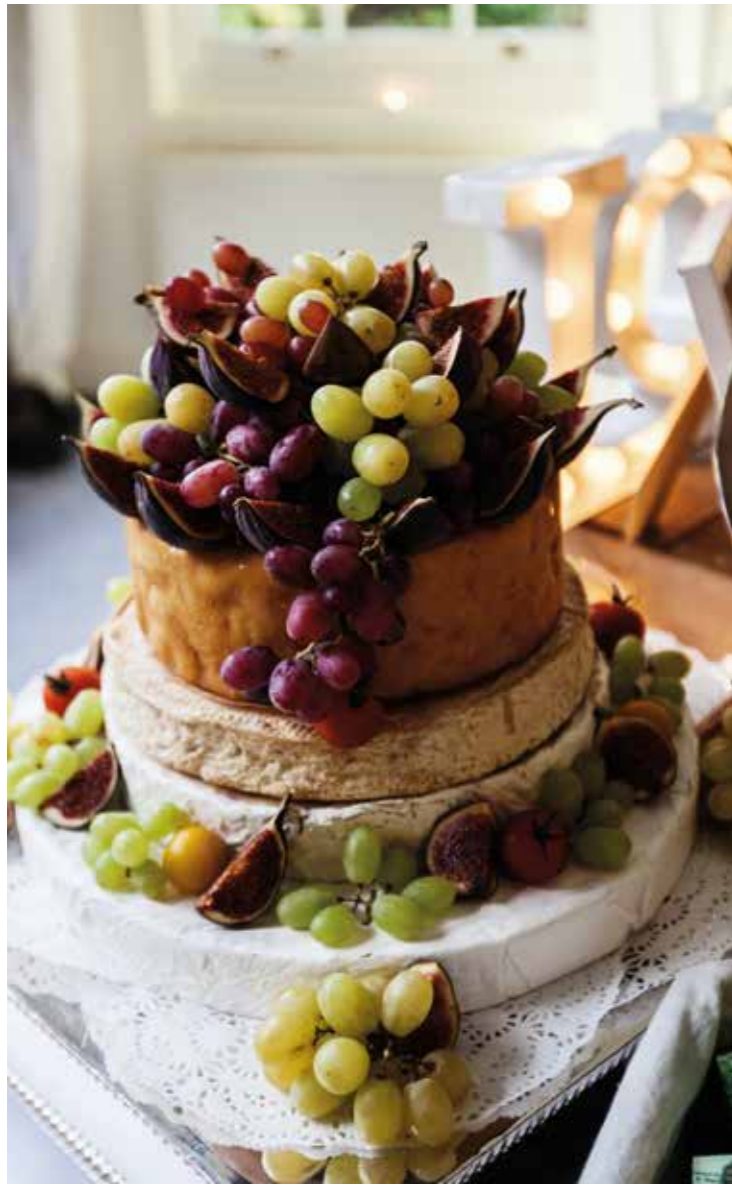
